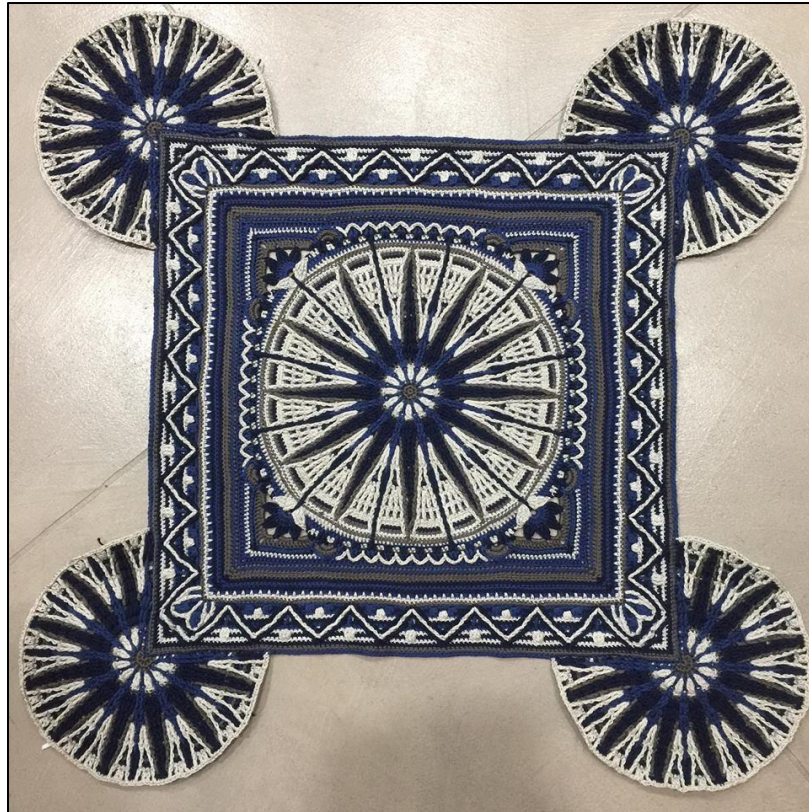


Baby Henry's Designer Heirloom Afghan Crochet Along {PART 9}



In this part, we will be continuing the partial corner mandalas.

Resources

- **Incorporated Designs:** This blanket incorporates patterns by three amazing designers. They are all beautifully written patterns with great photo tutorials. **You will need to purchase** “Mandala N°6” by CAROcreated, available on [Ravelry](#) or [Etsy](#), and “Dandelion Border-Overlay Crochet” by [Lilla Bjorn](#), also available on [Ravelry](#) or [Etsy](#). “Sophie’s Garden Squaring” by Dedri Uys is available on her [website](#). To assemble this blanket, you will need these three patterns and the modifications released in this CAL.

You will need yarn, an appropriately sized crochet hook and a tapestry needle for joining. For more details on this see the introduction information.

This pattern uses US terms

Special Stitches:

Ending Slip Stitch (ESS) – Remove the loop that is on your hook after the last stitch {left photo below}. Insert the hook, from the back, into both loops of the stitch from the round where you will be joining. Pull the loop through to the back. Cut the yarn leaving a tail for weaving in. Pull the tail through the loop {middle photo below}, and pull the tail to tighten the stitch a bit {right photo below} then weave in the ends. You can also watch the [video instructions here](#).



Starting Slip Stitch (SSS) – Insert hook into the indicated stitch in the round where you will be joining {left photo below}. Leaving a tail, pull through a loop of your new working yarn {middle photo below}, ch 1, {right photo below}. Pull the tail to tighten the stitch a bit. I recommend weaving in the ends as you go, either by crocheting over the tail as you complete the round or by another means shortly after completion of round. BEFORE YOU START:

1. Note that all single stitches in this pattern should be worked **BACK-LOOP ONLY** unless otherwise noted.
2. **For most rounds of the partial mandalas you will need these instructions and the original pattern. You should read through both the original pattern and these instructions for the round before starting.**
3. I recommend watching [this video](#) that will provide a tutorial on how to do the beginning and end joining.
4. Rounds 95-101 will be repeated on each of the corners of Part 6 to create the four partial corner mandalas.
5. Note that the joins will be rather visible at first. When all partial mandalas are completed, we will be making a slip stitch around that will hide this and make it look much tidier.

Instructions

Rounds 1-94

Instructions are in the previous parts.

Round 95

Join yarn with a slip stitch (both loops) in the 24th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

During the first repeat omit the first 6 stitches. Repeat from * to * of **rd 24** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 10 times. Omit last 4 sts of final repeat.

End with ESS (both loops) in the 24th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(100 stitches per mandala)

Round 96

Join yarn with a slip stitch (both loops) in the 25th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

Repeat from * to * of **rd 25** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times, 1 sc.

End with ESS (both loops) in the 25th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(109 stitches per mandala)

Round 97

Join yarn with a slip stitch (both loops) in the 26th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

5 sc, repeat from * to * of **rd 26** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times. Omit last 4 sts of final repeat.

End with ESS (both loops) in the 26th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(109 stitches per mandala)

Round 98

Join yarn with a slip stitch (both loops) in the 27th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

There are 4 FPdtr worked in each repeat. After the first and the second DO NOT skip a st, but sk 1 st after the third and fourth (original says to not skip after first and fourth – this change is needed to shift the sc when working the partial mandalas).

1 sc, FPdtr around the underlying dtr of round 92 (sk 1 st), 3 sc, FPdtr around the underlying dtr of round 92 (sk 1 st). Repeat from * to * of **rd 27** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times. Omit the last FPdtr-3sc-FPdtr.

End with ESS (both loops) in the 27th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(127 stitches per mandala)

Round 99

Join yarn with a slip stitch (both loops) in the 28th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

During the first repeat start with 6 sc instead of 7, repeat from * to * of **rd 28** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times, 2 sc.

End with ESS (both loops) in the 28th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(127 stitches per mandala)

Round 100

Join yarn with a slip stitch (both loops) in the 29th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

1 FLdtr2tog - work the 1st dtr in the st of round 94 just under the FPdtr of rd 96 (place this dtr to the right of the FPdtr from rd 95) and the 2nd dtr of this dtr2tog in the st of rd 94 which lie visible to the left of the FPdtr from rd 95 (sk 1 st), 5 sc, repeat from * to * of **rd 29** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times. During the last repeat omit the last 5 stitches AND working the last 2nd dtr in the st of round 94 just under (to the left of) the FPdtr of rd 96.

End with ESS (both loops) in the 29th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(136 stitches per mandala)

Round 101

Join yarn with a slip stitch (both loops) in the 30th stitch before the corner in rd 71

1 sc, 1 FPtr around the FPdtr of rd 98 (sk 1 st), 1 sc, 2 FLdc in the center sc of the 3 sc of rd 98 which lie between the two FPdtr of rd 98 (sk 2 sts), 1 sc, 1 FPtr around the next FPdtr of rd 98 (sk 1 st), 1 sc, repeat from * to * of **rd 30** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times. Omit last 5 sts of final repeat.

End with ESS (both loops) in the 30th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(145 stitches per mandala)



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
