

# Classic Scarf Crochet Pattern by Jolanta Urbaitiene

## Introduction.

Classic Scarf Crochet Pattern is my first design. It was made to take part in Design- A-Scarf- Challenge 2022.

Classic Scarf for those who love traditional scarfs, wear them under coats. It is warm and not too thick. I hope Classic Scarf will be a nice part for men's clothes also, friendly for all family members.

Classic Scarf Crochet Pattern is meant for Beginners. Chains and Single Crochet Stitches make a nice texture of this Scarf. I have used Chains and Slip Stitches to make tassels. It is easy to follow the Pattern Instructions because there are two rows that we need to repeat.

Pattern is written in US Crochet Terms. Metric system.

Read all Pattern before you have started work on it, please.

## Size

Width - 15 cm, Length - 122 cm (without tassels).

## Materials.

**Yarn:** Lana Gatto Merinocot (53% Lana Merino Extra-fine, 47 % Cotton), 50 g - 125 m, colour terracotta 14020, LOT 00609. 3 balls = 375 m.

**Hook :** Aluminium 4.00 mm.

**Scissors.**

**Darning Needle.**

**Measuring Tape.**

## Tension.

**Gauge Swatch:** 21stitches x 20 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm. Gauge Swatch is not necessary for this design.

## Stitch Guide and Abbreviations.

**Stitches :** Chain/s - ch/s; Single Crochet Stitch/es - sc/s; Slip stitch / sl st

**Abbreviations:** row - r/R, repeat - rep, skip stitch/es - sk st/s.

## Pattern Instructions.

### I. Scarf.

ch 33.

**R1** (Back Side): sc to 2nd ch from the Hook, (ch1, sk 1 st, sc), rep across r, sc to the last st, ch 1, turn (32 sts).

**R2** (Front Side): sc 1 to 1st st prev r, sk st, sc 2 around ch 1 prev r, (sk st, sc 2 around ch 1 prev r), rep across r, sc to the last st, ch 1, turn (32 sts).

**R 3:** rep R 1.

**R 4:** rep R 2.

Continue till you will reach your desired length. The last row of your scarf should be R2. Do not cut the yarn after the last row. You will continue to make Tassels.

## **II. Tassels.**

ch 10, sl st to 2nd ch from the hook, make 8 sl sts more (9 sl st in total), join via sl st around 2 ch prev row, make new tassel and join via sl st around the same 2 ch prev row ( you will have tassels around all 2ch prev r also, in first and the last sc).

## **Notes**

1. Make ch1 at the end of each row and turn clockwise to start a new row. You will get a nice line across both sides of your Classic Scarf (Pic ... and ...)

## **Further Development.**

1. I recommend thinner yarn for Women's Classic Scarf (suitable for Hook 3.00 mm - 3.5 mm).

2. I would recommend to use more than one colour of yarn if you will make it for the child.

3. I highly recommend to change colours of the yarn while you are working at the Back side.

4. You can make Scarf as long as you want.
