



GLADYS CROCHET SCARF

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Skill Level

Easy

Materials

Lion Brand Basic Stitch Anti-pilling Yarn 100% 185 yds (170 m), 3.5 oz (100 g) in Ecrú,
835 yds (764 m)

Hook - 6 mm (J)

Tapestry Needle

Tape Measure

Scissors

Gauge

17 sts x 9 rows = 4" x 4" (10 cm x 10 cm)

Finished Measurements

76" long x 16" wide (After blocking)

Abbreviations

Ch(s) - chain(s)

Sc - single crochet

Dc - double crochet

st - stitch

Shell - 4 dc in one ch or st

Sk - skip

Notes

This pattern is written in Standard US Terms.

Ch 3 at the beginning of the row does not count as a st.

Pattern Instructions

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Ch 320

Row 1: shell in 4th ch from hook, sk 3 chs, sc in next ch, *ch 4, sk next 4 chs, shell in next ch, sk next 3 chs, sc in next ch, rep from * to end, turn (36 shells, 35 chs).

Row 2: ch 3, shell in first st, sk next 3 sts, sc in next st, *ch 4, sk next ch 4, shell in next st, sk next 3 sts, sc in next st, rep from * to end, turn.

Rows 3-35: rep row 2.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
